

**NOTICE – DISPOSAL OF

To claim your property, you must personally appear in court on **Wednesday, February 3, 2010, at 2:00 p.m. at the following location:**

Division 16, Circuit Court of St. Louis (Judge Stephen R. Ohmer), 1st Floor, Carnahan Courthouse, 1114 Market Street, St. Louis, MO 63101

If you are the owner of any property you believe to be on the list, you may inquire in person at the Circuit Attorney's Warrant Office at Room 105 (1st Floor), Carnahan Courthouse, 1114 Market Street, St. Louis, MO 63101, to see if the item is on that list.

You do not have to appear in court if you are not interested in having the property returned to you.

If you do wish to claim property that belongs to you, please bring with you to court a valid form of identification and some proof of ownership of the property in question.
