**Workplace Shooting Victims Identified**  
*Suspect's Identity Released*

The Metropolitan Police Department, City of St. Louis ("the department") Homicide Division continues its investigation into the tragic shootings on January 7, 2010, at ABB Incorporated, a transformer manufacturing company, located at 4350 Semple Avenue.

Investigators have positively identified the deceased victims from the shooting as: Carlton J. Carter, a 57-year-old Black male of the 6000 block of Henner in St. Louis, Mo. Victim Carter was shot once in the head. He was found outside the building. He was pronounced dead at the scene. Terry Mabry, a 55-year-old White male of the 30 block of S. Shetland Trails in Moscow Mills, Mo. Victim Mabry was shot once in the leg and once in the head. He was found outside the building. He was pronounced dead at the scene. Cory Wilson, a 27-year-old White male of the 200 block of N. Combs in Collinsville, Ill. Victim Wilson was shot once in the shoulder and once in the head. He was found inside the building. He was pronounced dead at the scene.

The suspect responsible for the shootings has been identified as Timothy G. Hendron, a 51-year-old White male of the 300 block of Dobbin Rd in Webster Groves, Mo. Hendron died from a self-inflicted gunshot wound underneath the chin. He was found inside the building. He was pronounced dead at the scene.

Investigators have also identified the five victims who were shot and transported to area hospitals. The department does not receive updates on the conditions of victims because of HIPPA regulations. Conditions are those that were reported when the victims were admitted to hospitals yesterday with the exception of one victim who was treated and released yesterday. The following individuals were shot during the incident:

Darrell Buckley, a 51-year-old Black male of St. Louis was shot in the abdomen, chest and knee and was listed in critical condition. Stephen Sharp, a 55-year-old Black male of O'Fallon, Mo was shot in the abdomen he was also listed in critical condition. Keith Garner, a 51-year-old White Male of Florissant, Mo. was shot multiple times in the

leg and was listed in fair condition. John Green, a 56-year-old Black male of Ferguson, Mo. was shot in the arm with a shotgun pellet and listed in fair condition. Jerry Brown, a 52-year-old Black male of St. Louis was shot in the leg. He was treated and released from the hospital yesterday.

Homicide Investigators are still conducting interviews and gathering information, in an effort to determine what happened on the morning of the shootings and what might have lead to this tragic incident. All the victims, both deceased and injured, as well as the suspect were current employees of ABB. ABB company executives continue to work closely with investigators and witnesses have fully cooperated as it relates to this ongoing investigation. More information will be released as this lengthy investigation continues.
