

ST. LOUIS METROPOLITAN POLICE CITIZEN'S ACADEMY



The St. Louis Metropolitan Police Citizens Academy is a twelve-week course with one night of instruction held on Wednesday evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at Police Headquarters, located at 1915 Olive Street.

The next Citizens Academy class will begin on March 4, 2020 with the final class and graduation to be held on May 20, 2020.

Through the course, citizens gain better a understanding of the inner workings of the department through instruction in:

- the history & structure of the SLMPD
- predicting & analyzing crime patterns
- district patrol
- criminal investigations
- community policing techniques



Nearly all instruction is provided by commissioned police officers. The Citizens Academy promotes and enhances relations among the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department, local businesses, residents, and visitors, assures and implements community awareness of the criminal justice system, and provides volunteer support for law enforcement activities that impact the community.
